I would like to remind you that full uniform is expected until the end of your period at school and for **each external examination**. Pupils also need to make sure that they come to each exam equipped with a black biro and that they bring appropriate equipment when needed e.g. for the maths examinations. Guidance to external exams where distributed before Easter and is available on the school website.

Full attendance is essential up to the end of the day on the 26th of May. Pupils must attend every exam they have been entered for.
