The clock struck 12 and I eventually fell asleep.


When I woke up that mysterious creature was rumbling in my head I said, "I'm going to find this creature."



"No, of-course I won't tell," I said.


So... I had a new friend! My only true friend. But the next time she disappeared, she was gone forever.



The Pokémon Disasier


One beautiful morning Pikachu decided to go out surfing, but when he got to the beach there were other Pokémon there like Raichu, Pikachu's arch enemy.

"Is that a shiny Gyarados!" said the trainer, "I must catch it."







I live in a big white house.


I come from driving a tractor up a big hill.
