Mae ein llongyfarchiadau yn mynd i'r 9 ohonynt ar ganlyniadau arbennig iawn, ac i'r holl ddisgyblion eraill a llwyddodd i gyrraedd y graddau uwch mewn nifer o'u pynciau.

Ysgol Dyffryn Conwy is delighted to announce our best ever results this year. Our pupils have really excelled themselves this year with an almost 8% increase on previous results in the main indicator for 5A*-Cs or more following exceptional results in mathematics and an increase across the language GCSEs. These are excellent results and we are extremely proud of our pupils' successes and congratulate them and their families on these superb results! Their successes are well deserved and we look forward to welcoming the majority of pupils back to the 6th form.

Once again a number of pupils have reached the highs with a number of A*/As. This year, our highest achieving pupils include: Anna Carpena 8A*, 4A, as well as a Distinction in additional mathematics and a B grade in AS Italian; Cadi Edwards 8A*, 3A and a Merit in additional mathematics; also excelling was Amelia Maddox with 6A*, 4A and a Distinction in additional mathematics. A number of other pupils also gained above the 5A*/A threshold this year including: Gwion Jones 4A*, 4A, 2B; Chloe Congreve 3A*, 4A, 3B; Elin Cawley 1A*, 6A, B a C; Rhydian Jones and Hannah Roberts 1A*, 5A, 4B each; and Owain Williams A*, 5A, 2B a C. Our congratulations go to all 9 – these are superb results! - along with congratulating all our other pupils who have achieved in the highest grades across many of their subjects.

As a Headteacher I am extremely proud to see all the happy faces confirming what success means to our young people and how hard they have worked especially over the last two years. They fully deserve their success and they are a credit to their families, the school and to the wider community. I would also like to

take this opportunity to thank all my staff for their continuous hard work. This has been another excellent year for the school.
