

## The Skills Challenge Certificate 2018 - 2020

The Skills Challenge Certificate consists of four components which are followed by all pupils in year 12 and 13:

- Individual Project
- Enterprise and Employability Challenge
- Global Citizenship Challenge
- Community Challenge

The Skills Challenge Certificate provides experiences which will enable learners to be better prepared for their future destination, whether university, further training or employment.

### Skills Challenge Certificate Assessment Plan 2018-2020

Challenge	Weighting	Completion Date
Citizenship Challenge	15%	Completed by December 2019 (yr. 12)
Enterprise and Employability Challenge	20%	To be completed July 2019 (yr. 12)
Community Challenge	15%	To be completed July 2019 (yr. 12)
Individual Project	50%	To be completed January 2020 (yr. 13)

To achieve A\* / A pupils must achieve **DISTINCTION** in all challenges.

To achieve B / C pupils must achieve **MERIT** in all challenges.

To achieve D / E pupils must achieve **PASS** in all challenges.

**Community challenge** lessons have been integrated into tutorial lessons. The majority of this challenge requires the pupils to work independently on 30 hours of community work, either within the school or with agreed partners outside of school.

To pass the challenge, there are 3 tasks:

1. Project Proposal
2. 30 hours community work
3. Personal Reflection Presentation

**The Enterprise Challenge** will be completed in the two timetabled lessons. These are named as 'Menter' on the timetable.

To pass the challenge, there are 4 tasks:

1. Pen Portrait
2. Innovation Proposal (the group task)
3. Destination Passport
4. Personal Reflection Presentation

**The Citizenship Challenge** will be completed in the two timetabled lessons. These are named as 'BAC' on the timetable.

To pass the challenge, there are 3 tasks:

1. Personal Standpoint
2. Contribution to global choices conference
3. Personal Reflection

**The Individual Project** will begin in year 12 (there will be a period of skill development lessons following the completion of the Citizenship challenge). However, in year 13 there will be two timetabled lessons on the timetable.
