I sylw Disgyblion blwyddyn 12 a'u Rhieni / F.A.O. Year 12 Students and Parents

Annwyl Myfyriwr a Rhiant,

Ysgrifennaf atoch i gadarnhau'r trefniadau am weddill y flwyddyn ysgol ynglŷn â phresenoldeb ac arholiadau allanol. Gweler y manylion isod :-

- Bydd y cyfnod arholiadau allanol ffurfiol yn cychwyn dydd Llun y 13eg o Fai. Mae amserlen arholiadau unigol wedi ei rannu efo'ch plentyn. Pe dymunent wirio neu gasglu amserlen newydd, dylent gysylltu â Mrs Delyth Williams, Swyddog Arholiadau'r Ysgol.
- Disgwylir y disgyblion i gyrraedd eu harholiadau ar amser - cyn 9am y bore a 1pm yn y pwn. Os ydynt yn absennol oherwydd salwch dylid cysylltu â'r ysgol yn syth. Bydd angen llythyr/nodyn doctor.
- Bydd cyfnodau astudio/gwersi yn cael eu cynnal o amgylch yr arholiadau lle'n bosib cefnogi astudio annibynnol y disgyblion yn yr ysgol a gartref.

Er gwybodaeth hefyd:

- Bydd y cyrsiau Linc cyn yr arholiadau ar ddydd Mercher yr 8fed o Fai. Byddent yn ail gychwyn ar y 5ed o Fehefin hyd y 19eg o Fehefin.
- Yn dilyn yr arholiadau UG, fe fydd presenoldeb llawn am weddill y flwyddyn ysgol yn hanfodol. Bydd paratoi ar gyfer y cyrsiau A2 yn cychwyn yn syth ar ôl yr arholiadau UG.
- Mae rhaglen o weithgareddau ar gyfer sicrhau cyflawniad llawn o 3 o'r 4 Her Sgiliau fel rhan o'r cymhwyster y Fagloriaeth Gymreig.
- Bydd gweithgareddau amrywiol hefyd wedi eu trefnu er mwyn cyflawni Passport Dysgu pob disgybl gan gynnwys cychwyn ar y broses o baratoi ar gyfer ceisiadau UCAS a llwybr Prifysgol. Bydd gweithdai yn cael eu cynnal gan Brifysgolion yn rhan o'r cynllun hon ac anogir cyfranogiad llawn gan ddisgyblion yn y broses er mwyn sicrhau eu bod wedi **gwblhau** eu proses ymchwilio a'u datganiadau unigol cyn diwedd Mehefin 2019.
- Mae presenoldeb yn yr ysgol o ddechrau Mehefin yn allweddol er mwyn sicrhau fod y gwaith cynllunio wedi ei gwblhau erbyn diwedd y tymor.
- Bydd cyfle hefyd i gefnogi gweithgareddau pontio Bl.6 yn ystod wythnos yr 2il – 5ed o Orffennaf, 2019.
- Mae cyfle i ddisgyblion sydd yn dymuno gwneud profiad gwaith ar gael yn ystod pythefnos olaf y tymor - **8fed - 19eg o Orffennaf**. Bydd cyfleoedd hefyd i ddisgyblion wneud neu gwblhau'r elfen Her Gymunedol o'r fagloriaeth yn yr ysgol a/neu ein cymuned ehangach yn ystod y pythefnos hwn drwy gyfrannu at/arwain gweithgareddau traws-ysgol gyda disgyblion iau. Anogwn ddisgyblion i drafod gydag arweinwyr pwnc os oes diddordeb ganddynt mewn maes penodol.
- Ni wneir taliadau EMA am absenoldebau anawdurdodedig yn ystod y cyfnod hwn.

Dear Parent/Guardian and 6th Former,

I write to confirm the arrangements for the remainder of the school year with regards to attendance and external examinations. Details are given below: -



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- The formal external examination period begins Monday the 13th of May. An individual examination timetable has been shared with your child last term. If they need to check any of their exams or request an additional copy, they need to contact, Mrs Delyth Williams, Examinations Officer.
- Pupils need to ensure that they arrive promptly for each examination – before 9am in the morning or before 1pm in the afternoon. If a student is absent due to a medical reason – please phone in as soon as possible. A medical note/letter will be needed.
- Lessons/Revision sessions will be held around the examination timetable where possible to support students' independent study at school and at home.

Additional information:

- The last Link courses before the AS exams will be on Wednesday the 8th of May. They will re-start between the 5th and 19th of June.
- Following the AS exams, full attendance will be vital for the remainder of the school year. Preparation for A2 courses will start immediately after the AS exams.
- During this period, a programme of activities to ensure that 3 of the 4 Skills Challenge Certificate components have been completed as part of the Welsh Bacalaureate.
- A range of activities have also been arranged to complete the Learning Passport, including preparation for UCAS and University Pathways. Workshops with two Universities have also been arranged during this period and we would encourage full participation in this process to ensure that pupils have researched possible pathways and courses and completed their individual statements by the end of June, 2019.
- Attendance in school from the beginning of June is essential to ensure that planning for year 13 has been completed before the end of term.
- There will also be the opportunity to support year 6 transition week 2 – 5th of July, 2019.
- For pupils wishing to undertake work experience before the end of term, the final two weeks of term are available (8th – 19th of July). There will also be opportunities for pupils to undertake or complete their community involvement work within the school and its wider community by supporting/leading cross-curricular activities with younger pupils. We would encourage pupils to speak to subject leaders if they are interested in a specific area.
- No EMA payments will be made for unauthorised absences during this period.
