What is KiVa?

KiVa is a program that has been developed at the University of Turku, Finland.

- KiVa is an acronym for Kiusaamista Vasteen, which is Finnish for 'against' (Ki) 'bullying' (Va).
- At Ysgol Dyffryn Conwy we promote this through our motto 'Be kind'
- The whole school approach of the program focuses on the behaviour of everyone in a bullying situation in order to ensure that our learners feel safe, confident and happy.
- The aim is to empower the pupils so that, instead of encouraging the bully, they support the victim and show that they do not condone bullying.
- The KiVa Health lessons focus on being attentive and empathetic by fostering integrity, responsibility and kindness in our learners.
